



General Safety at Eastercamp 2024

The following is general safety information to help you enjoy the event.

COVID-19 & Flu

CYS always works closely with local and national agencies to plan for a safe event. We monitor and prepare for possible public health emergencies during the camp.

Stay home and avoid attending a Eastercamp if you are:

- unwell
- a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19
- self-isolating

Emergency Information

Follow the directions of the Safety Team and CYS Staff if there is any type of emergency.

General Safety

If you see someone acting suspicious or see something suspicious, say something by speaking to your Youth Leader, the Safety Team, or CYS Staff.

- Carry details of any medications and allergies with you.
- Remain hydrated by drinking plenty of water.

When you are at the BigTop or EC Village:

- Take a moment to identify at least two exit routes from the area
- If an alarm sounds, evacuate immediately. Follow directions from the Safety Team

Protecting your property:

- If parking onsite, lock your vehicle and never leave valuables or personal items on display.
- If you lose personal property, report it immediately to the Info Centre.
- Name everything.



Emergency Evacuations

In the event of an emergency evacuation, make your way quickly and calmly to an emergency exit. Be aware of any hazards or dangers around you, and proceed to a safe area. Follow the advice of the Safety Team. Do not put yourself in danger by stopping to collect belongings unless directed to. Please view the full fire evacuation procedure on the Eastercamp website.

Travel

At peak times (Thursday night & Monday afternoon) traffic may be heavy and very busy. We recommend travelling to and from Eastercamp in a group bus or at the very least by car-pooling.

Weather

The weather during Easter can change rapidly. Make note of weather forecasts and pay special attention to any weather alerts.

If it becomes necessary to cancel or postpone any part of the event due to inclement weather (such as strong winds or heavy rain) updates will be issued on social media (Instagram and Facebook) and through your youth group key leader.

Enjoy the event and when in doubt, seek assistance from your Youth Leader or the Safety Team. Have a great camp!
